

Clermont County Township Association Meeting

Date: November 16, 2017

Host: Williamsburg Township

Meeting was called to order: Mrs. Batchler called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm and thanked everyone for coming. She asked everyone to stand for the pledge of allegiance. Mr. McGee led the opening prayer. Dinner was then served.
