

Clermont County Township Association Meeting

Date: November 19, 2015

Host: Williamsburg Township

Meeting was called to order: Mrs. Batchler called the meeting to order at 6:35 pm and thanked everyone for coming. She then asked everyone to stand for the pledge of allegiance. Mr. Perry led the opening prayer. Dinner was then served.

Opening remarks: A motion was made by Guy Bainum and seconded by Lloyd Acres to appoint Greg Carson to serve on the OKI Board. Motion passed.

The Ohio Township Association notified all counties that the yearly dues for members will be increasing in 2016.
